SILOAH'S BELIEFS ON THE LORD'S SUPPER

The Lord's Supper is:

- a gift which Christ our Lord has given to His Church.
- a tangible form of the Gospel that forgives us our sins.
- a Sacrament that expresses the full extent of Christ's love for His Church.
- an expression of unity and oneness in faith and doctrine.

The Lord's Supper is not:

- open to anyone and everyone.
- open to unbelievers or those who reject Jesus as the eternal Son of God.
- open to those who disagree with the doctrine and teachings of Siloah and the Wisconsin Synod.
- open to anyone who holds membership in a church that is not in fellowship with Siloah.

Scripture plainly says:

"The cup of blessing which we bless, is it not the communion of the blood of Christ? The bread which we break, is it not the communion of the body of Christ? For we, though many, are one bread and one body. For we all partake of that one bread."

-1 Corinthians 10:16,17

There must be unity and agreement before there is participation in the body and blood of Christ.

"Therefore whoever eats this bread or drinks this cup of The Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of the body and blood of The Lord. But let a person examine her/himself, and so let her/him eat of the bread and drink of the cup. For whoever eats and drinks in an unworthy manner, eats and drinks judgment to her/himself, not discerning The Lord's body."

-1 Corinthians 11:27-29

The Lord's Supper is intended to bless us, but if received "in an unworthy manner," it may harm us.

Out of love and respect for our Lord Jesus, instruction is given before we receive the Sacrament. All Siloah Partners have been instructed in The Lord's Supper and hold to the beliefs printed above. If you are not a member of Siloah, neither a member of a Wisconsin Synod church nor a member of a congregation in fellowship with WELS, we gently ask that you refrain from receiving the Sacrament of The Lord's Supper.

Remember the reception of The Lord's Supper does not make us Christians, nor does not receiving the Sacrament make us unbelievers. There will be people in Heaven from all different Christian church-denominations. For Jesus tells us in Mark 16:16, "Whoever believes and is baptized shall be saved." In Heaven there will be no need for church-denominations, for everyone will be united in love and understanding of God's good and perfect will.

However, here, in this fallen world, plagued with sin, corruption and misunderstanding, there are church-denominations. Wherever a person pledges membership is their public proclamation of what they believe.

Siloah's Historian

"This is the history of the heavens and the earth when they were created, on the day that the Lord God made the earth and the heavens." -Genesis 2:4

Siloah's Historian—The historian shall perform the duties printed below and shall be present at historical gatherings, such as Church Anniversaries, School Openings, and Pastor Installations.

Qualifications

Siloah's Historian shall be:

1. A Siloah Partner in good standing, with regular worship attendance and participation in The Lord's Supper.
2. A Christian role model in attitude, speech and actions
3. Committed to honoring the rich past of Siloah while celebrating the current and present blessings that God provides.
4. Able to work cooperatively with the Pastor, church and school staff, and members of the congregation.
5. Computer knowledgeable
6. Able to work with people from different cultures, economic situations, and backgrounds.

General Responsibilities

The Historian:

- Prays for the congregation, the school, the Pastor and all the School Staff members.
- Studies God's Word and worships with the congregation as often as possible.
- Notates and highlights important events in the history of the church and school.
- Keeps the congregation focused on historical events, dates, and occasions.
- Documents the special days and events connected with the church and the school.
- Performs special tasks as assigned by the Pastor or Church Council.

Specific Duties

The Historian shall:

1. Call attention to the church's anniversary and the school's inception. Siloah Lutheran Church was founded in 1894 and celebrates its founding in 5 year increments. Siloah Lutheran School was founded in 1962 and celebrates its founding in 10 year increments.
2. Document and keep record of the Pastors, Principals, and Teachers, that serve at the church or the school.
3. Save records in handwritten, electronic, or typed form and preserve a printed hard copy to be kept on campus and keep a copy off campus so that there is a backup of all files.
4. Set up a historical display during Church and School anniversaries.
5. Be instrumental in planning and executing anniversary celebrations for church and school.
6. Be present at significant historical events, such as School Kickoffs, Church Picnics, Anniversaries, Pastor Ordinations, Teacher Installations, etc.
