When someone goes to jail or prison, it has an impact on their family and others. How can Christians respond with the love of Christ and be a blessing to them?

A few WELS members have been discussing ways to serve children and families in our schools, churches and neighborhoods who have been impacted by incarceration. ¹⁴How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of ¹⁶whom they have not heard?

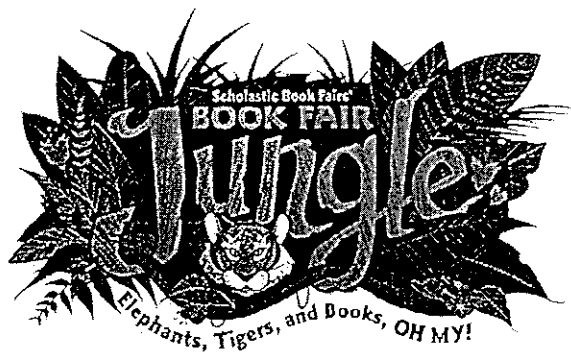

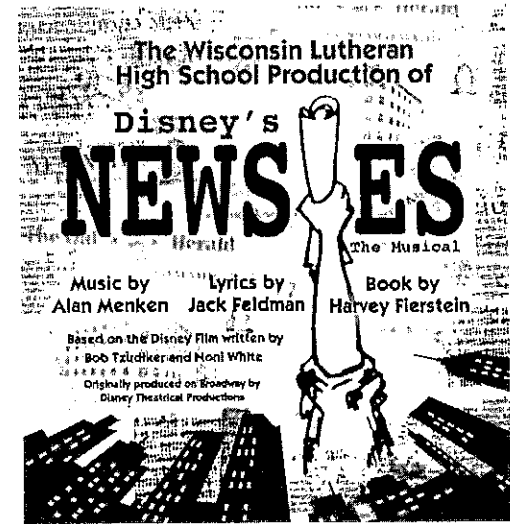
