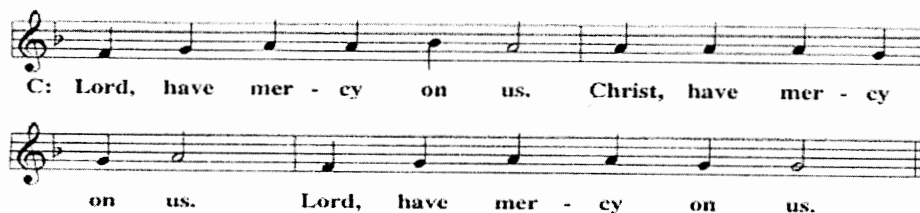

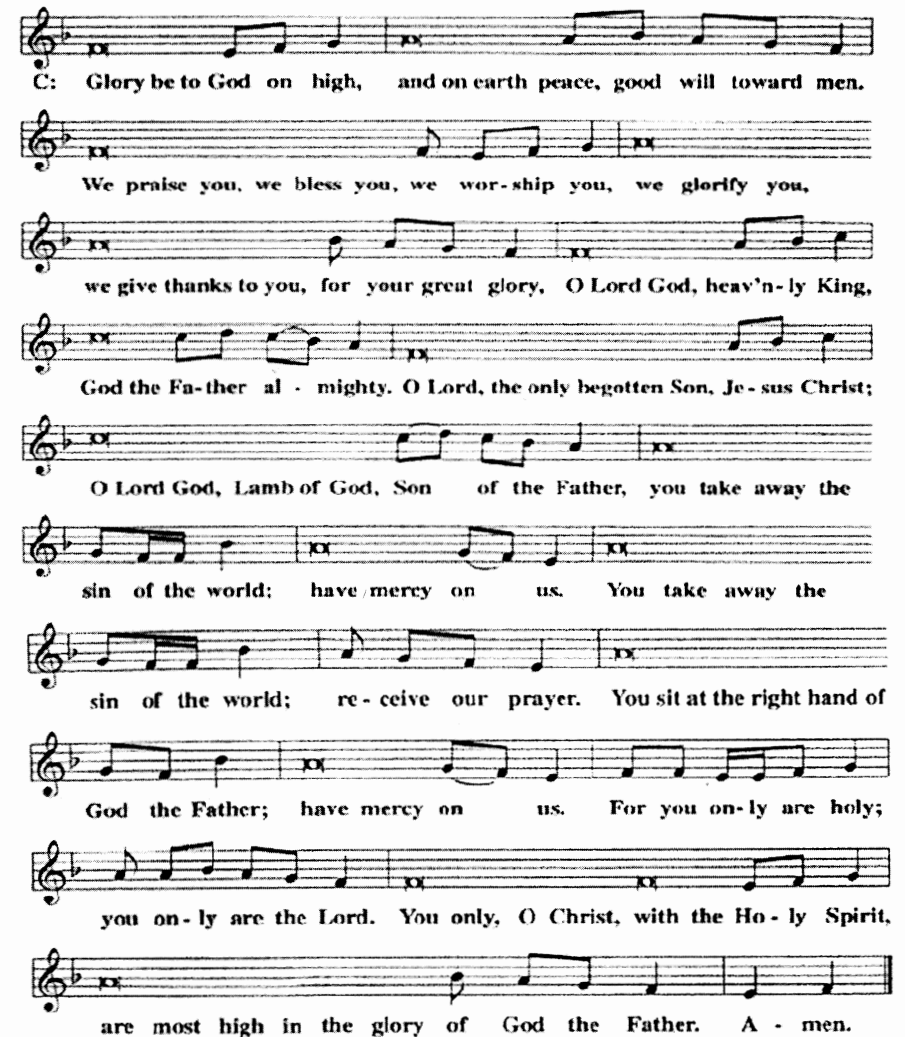
CONFESSION

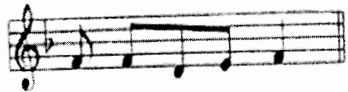


ABSOLUTION
