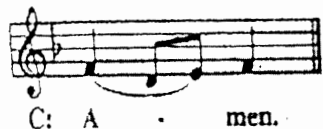

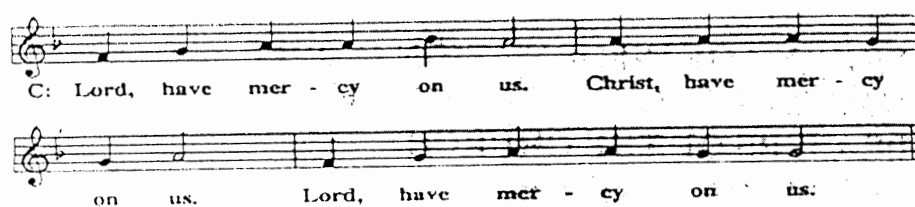
"Now Thank We All Our God"

Pastor Coleman: The Lord be with you.



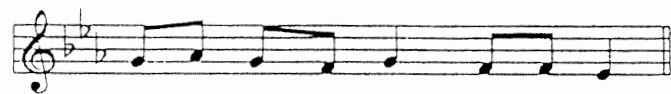

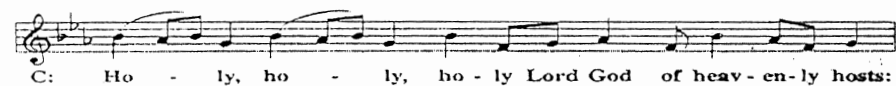
Pastor Coleman: Let us give thanks to The Lord, our God.

18 But I ask: Did they not hear? Of course they did:




