### **ENTRY OF SILOAH'S PROCESSIONAL CROSS**

*As the processional cross enters the Sanctuary,  
the congregation stands and fixes all eyes on the cross until it is set in place near the  
Lectern.*

*Siloah's Processional Cross is then dedicated to The Lord with the following words:*

Pastor Coleman: Lift high the cross. The love of Christ proclaim...

**Congregation: 'Til all the world adore His sacred name!**

Pastor Coleman: In the name of The Father, and of The Son, and of The Holy Spirit!

**Congregation: Amen!**

Pastor Coleman: The cross that once inflicted pain has become a symbol of triumph!  
Jesus' empty tomb has transformed the cruel and ugly cross into an image of hope,  
peace, and joy!

Pastor Coleman: Lift high the cross. The love of Christ proclaim...

**Congregation: 'Til all the world adore His sacred name!**

Pastor Coleman: Jesus purchased the world's salvation on the cross of Calvary.  
Therefore, the cross is the symbol and insignia of our faith.

**Congregation: We love the cross, but sadly, there are some who despise it.**

**Pastor Coleman: As it is written: For the message of the cross is foolishness to  
those who are perishing...**

**Congregation: But to us who being saved, it is the power of God.**

Pastor Coleman: Lift high the cross. The love of Christ proclaim...

**Congregation: 'Til all the world adore His sacred name!**

Furthermore King David said to all the congregation: "My son Solomon, whom alone God has chosen, is young and inexperienced, and the work is great, because the Temple is not for man but for The Lord God. Now for the house of my God I have prepared with all my might gold for things to be made of gold, silver for things of silver, bronze for things of bronze, iron for things of iron, wood for things of wood, onyx stones, stones to be set, glistening stones of various colors, all kinds of precious stones, and marble slabs in abundance. Moreover, because I have set my affection on the house of my God, I have given to the house of my God, over and above all that I have prepared for the holy house, my own special treasure of gold and silver; three thousand talents of gold, of the gold of Ophir, and seven thousand talents of refined silver, to overlay the walls of the houses; the gold for things of gold and the silver for things of silver, and for all kinds of work to be done by the hands of craftsmen. Pastor Coleman: Let us give thanks to The Lord, our God!


**Congregation: It is right to give Him thanks and praise!**




