## BAPTISM OF JESUS January 12, 2020


Precious Lord, Take My Hand- Hymn #451




Pastor: In the peace of forgiveness, let us praise The Lord.






Pastor Coleman: Our Gospel Lesson is recorded in Matthew chapter 3.

Pastor Coleman: This is the Gospel of our Lord.



#### Romans 10:14-18 (NIV)

<sup>14</sup> How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of <sup>16</sup> whom they have not heard?

And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? <sup>15</sup> And how can anyone preach unless they are sent? As it is written: "How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!"<sup>10</sup>

But not all the Israelites accepted the good news. For Isaiah says, "Lord, who has believed our message?"<sup>10</sup> <sup>17</sup> Consequently, faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word about Christ. <sup>19</sup> But I ask: Did they not hear? Of course they did:

"Their voice has gone out into all the earth, their words to the ends of the world."
