#### LORD HAVE MERCY


Pastor Coleman: For all that we need in life, and for the wisdom to use all Your gifts with gratitude and joy, hear our prayer, O Lord.







Pastor Coleman: The peace of The Lord be with you always.



















# DISTRIBUTION OF HOLY COMMUNION
