We demonstrate this bond in what we call COMMUNION FELLOWSHIP. **Newcomers and Visitors** are asked to make a public declaration of faith to establish communion fellowship before communing. We are eager to help you take this step!

Lord Jesus, You call all who are weary and burdened to come to You for rest. Rejoicing in Your grace, we now come to this heavenly feast in which You give Your children on earth Your true body and blood to eat and to drink. Remove from us the soiled garments of self-righteousness and sin, and clothe us with the righteousness purchased with Your blood. Strengthen our faith, increase our love, especially for those with whom we share this blessed communion, and after this life grant us a place at Your heavenly table.

During communion service, we ask that the first two rows of pews be reserved for members who are not able to climb or kneel on the altar. Members sitting in the **first row pew** will be served communion at the pew. Members sitting in the **second row pew** may stand and come forward to the base of the stairs to receive their communion.

**DID YOU KNOW?** 

**November 1999** – The Pilgrims made a contract with the Advance Shade and Drapery Shop to install custom fabric draperies with linings and traverse rods in Hoffman Hall.

**February 2001**– In addition, the same company furnished and installed lined draperies with Kirsch superfine traverse rods for the church rectory/parsonage. This was done while one of our pastor's wife/widow was still living there.

October 2005 – The Pilgrims organization published and distributed a 30th year anniversary cookbook (1976-2006). Pilgrim members and others in the church submitted recipes supporting our efforts to help make the cookbook a success. Your input was greatly appreciated.

April 2006 – The Pilgrims paid for replacement of outdated, nonworking water fountains on main floor outside of pulpit area and in the lower level outside of Hoffmann Hall with refrigerated, water fountains bringing them within code.

Over the years the women of this group have displayed their passion for Christian service and being good stewards, by interacting with the pastors regarding needs of the church. We love sharing our time and talents with God's people. Additional information on the Pilgrims' accomplishments will be shared in next week's church bulletin.
