DID YOU KNOW?

February 2010- October 2012— The Pilgrims purchased 52 Bibles, 28 of them are large print. They are available for the purpose of individuals who attend Bible class at 9AM before worship service on Sunday. Later in December 2012, they purchased sixteen more Bibles to give to people who completes the Adult Bible Information Classes.

**February 16, 2012**— After the flood of 2010, the Pilgrims donated \$3000 to Siloah to replace kitchen utensils.

**June 2014**– There was a burglary at the Siloah's school office. Laptops and cash were confiscated, cabinet locks and church windows were broken. The Pilgrims donated \$3000 to help replace those items.

**February 2016**— The left service screen projector was not in service for a long time. Thereafter the Pilgrims purchased a new projector.
