Pastor: In the name of The Father, and of The Son, and of

Assembly: Amen.

Pastor: Blessed is the one who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor stands in the path of sinners, nor sits in the seat of the scornful, but whose delight is in the law of The Lord.
