"Jesus Christ Is Risen Today" -Hymn# 157 Pastor: In the name of The Father and of The Son (+), and of The Holy Spirit.

Response: Amen.

P: Christ is risen!

R: He is risen indeed!

P: Christ died for all, that those who live should no longer live for themselves, but for Him Who died for them and was raised again.

R: Thanks be to God!

P: If anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!

R: Sing a new song to The Lord, for He has done marvelous things!

P: For you were once darkness, but now you are light in The Lord.

R: A city on a hill cannot be hidden. Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl.

P: If we live, we live to The Lord; and if we die, we die to The Lord. So, whether we live or die, we belong to The Lord.

R: Thanks be to God! He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.
