## **Jearleana Parker Obituary**

Jearleana "Jerri" Parker

April 13, 1937 - April 11, 2024

Jearleana "Jerri/Squeaky" Parker, 86, of Indianapolis, Indiana, and the matriarch of two families, died in the presence of loved ones on April 11, 2024.

Jearleana was born on April 13, 1937, in England, Arkansas. Her father, Mack Jordan, and mother, Kalester Lovelace, both preceded her in death.

After living in several states, she eventually settled in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, and met the love of her life, James E. Parker (deceased). They were married for 47 years. They were blessed with eight children, Dr. Carolyn Parker, Patricia Parker, Lynnette Parker (deceased), Anthony Johnson (deceased) (Cheryl Johnson), Ricky Parker, Michael Parker (deceased), Dr. Dawn Rhodes (Jeffery Rhodes deceased), and James Christopher Parker. Jerri worked in many fields including packaging, insurance, real estate, and nursing. She spent over half of her life in Toledo, Ohio.

In her forties, Jerri went to nursing school and earned her associate degree in nursing from Com Tech at the University of Toledo. She passed her state boards becoming a registered nurse in 1983 at the age of 46. She then worked as a nurse for Owens Corning and Chrysler Corporation (formerly Jeep Co.) where she retired in 1997.

She was a faithful member of a Wisconsin Evangelical Lutheran Synod congregation in any city she lived; Siloah, Living Waters, Zion, Hosanna, Resurrection, and was most recently a member of Bethlehem in Carmel, Indiana. Jerri always gave selflessly to others. In 2005 she received the National President's Volunteer Service Award.

The award recognized her dedication to volunteer service and her demonstration of values that make our nation strong. She helped build a culture of citizenship, services, and responsibility in America.

Jerri Parker is survived by three supportive siblings, Larry (Janice) Jordan, Vervely (Garry) Williams, and Arvy (Linda) Jordan; her adopted daughter, Sond Faulkner; 18 loving grandchildren, 19 great-grandchildren, and a multitude of nieces, nephews, cousins, and close friends.

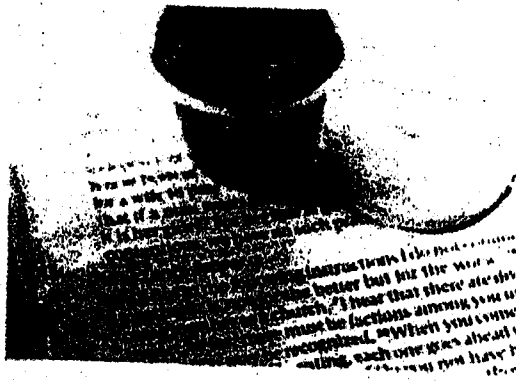

## **SILOAH'S BELIEFS ON THE LORD'S SUPPER**

The Lord's Supper is:

- *a gift which Christ our Lord has given to His Church.*
- *a tangible form of the Gospel that forgives us our sins.*
- *a Sacrament that expresses the full extent of Christ's love for His Church.*
- *an expression of unity and oneness in faith and doctrine.*

The Lord's Supper is not:

- *open to anyone and everyone.*
- *open to unbelievers or those who reject Jesus as the eternal Son of God.*
- *open to those who disagree with the doctrine and teachings of Siloah and the Wisconsin Synod.*
- *open to anyone who holds membership in a church that is not in fellowship with Siloah.*

Scripture plainly says:

**"The cup of blessing which we bless, is it not the communion of the blood of Christ? The bread which we break, is it not the communion of the body of Christ? For we, though many, are one bread and one body. For we all partake of that one bread."**

**-1 Corinthians 10:16,17**

***There must be unity and agreement before there is participation in the body and blood of Christ.***

**"Therefore whoever eats this bread or drinks this cup of The Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of the body and blood of The Lord. But let a person examine her/himself, and so let her/him eat of the bread and drink of the cup. For whoever eats and drinks in an unworthy manner, eats and drinks judgment to her/himself, not discerning The Lord's body."**

**-1 Corinthians 11:27-29**

***The Lord's Supper is intended to bless us, but if received "in an unworthy manner," it may harm us.***

**Out of love and respect for our Lord Jesus, instruction is given before we receive the Sacrament. All Siloah Partners have been instructed in The Lord's Supper and hold to the beliefs printed above. If you are not a member of Siloah, neither a member of a Wisconsin Synod church nor a member of a congregation in fellowship with WELS, we gently ask that you refrain from receiving the Sacrament of The Lord's Supper.**

**Remember the reception of The Lord's Supper does not make us Christians, nor does not receiving the Sacrament make us unbelievers. There will be people in Heaven from all different Christian church-denominations. For Jesus tells us in Mark 16:16, "Whoever believes and is baptized shall be saved." In Heaven there will be no need for church-denominations, for everyone will be united in love and understanding of God's good and perfect will.**

**However, here, in this fallen world, plagued with sin, corruption and misunderstanding, there are church-denominations. Wherever a person pledges membership is their public proclamation of what they believe.**
