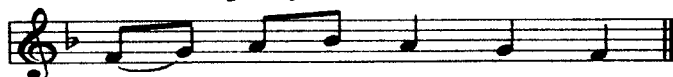

"We don't have the chance to discuss this topic in depth in class, so it was eye-opening to hear Pastor Loersch explain who the 'poor' really are. It's not just about financial struggles. It can also mean people who are poor in spirit, those facing emotional pain or spiritual emptiness. He reminded us that reaching out to the poor isn't just an option; it's a command from God. This presentation helped me see both the challenges and the opportunities in reaching out to people who are struggling, and why it's essential to approach them with humility, patience, and compassion, creating a space where they feel seen, valued, and safe. Through that kind of love, we reflect the kindness and mercy of Christ himself.

Siloah's Beliefs on The Sacrament of the Altar (Communion)

The Sacrament of the Altar is:

- A gift which Christ our Lord has given to His Church
- A tangible form of The Gospel that assures us of sins forgiven
- A sacred act that expresses the full extent of Christ's love for His Church
- An expression of unity and oneness in faith with those that take it together

The Sacrament of the Altar is not:

- A sacred act that shows one Christian's superiority over another Christian
- To be consumed by anyone outside of the Christian Church
- Intended for unbelievers
- To be taken at Siloah until a person confesses unity with Siloah and the Wisconsin Evangelical Lutheran Synod (WELS)

Scripture says:

"Is not the cup of thanksgiving for which we give thanks a participation in the blood of Christ? And is not the bread that we break a participation in the body of Christ? Because there is one loaf, we, who are many, are one body, for we all share the one loaf." – 1 Corinthians 10:16-17

"So then, whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of sinning against the body and blood of the Lord." – 1 Corinthians 11:27
