Congregation: And also with you.

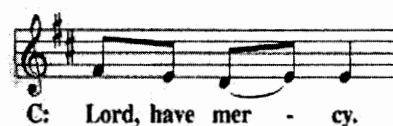

Congregation: Amen.

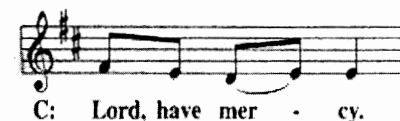
Pastor Coleman: For all that we need in life, and for the wisdom to use all Your gifts with gratitude and joy, hear our prayer, O Lord.



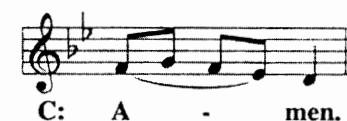
