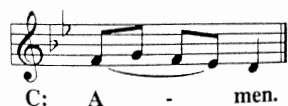
Pastor Coleman: In the peace of forgiveness, let us praise The Lord.

Movie encourages witnessing

To the Ends of the Earth is the fourth and final installment in a series of WELS outreach movies that includes *The Road to Emmaus*, *Come Follow Me*, and *My Son, My Savior*. While all the films point to Jesus as the Savior of the world, *To the Ends of the Earth* isn't focused on a part of Jesus' life as the other three are. Instead it tells the story of the apostle Paul taking the Word of Life to Philippi.

"Since the movie focuses on mission activity, it reminds us of the important work that we have as we serve Christ—to reach out with the gospel to the ends of the earth," says Rev. Mike Hintz, retired director of WELS Commission on Evangelism and consultant for the film.

Through Sept. 7, congregations can order the film in bulk—100 copies for \$200, plus shipping—to distribute to members and prospects. They also can use the film's resources—including worship materials for WELS Mission & Ministry Sunday; Bible studies

on witnessing for adults, small groups, teens, and children; an Advent by Candlelight program; and personal reflections—to help individuals apply the film's message.

A special opportunity to take these lessons and put them into practice is the upcoming synodwide outreach campaign called C18. The goal of this campaign is to reach communities around the country with the gospel message "A Light in the darkness" by Christmas Eve 2018.

"We want to reach one million people with the gospel by Christmas Eve 2018. That will only happen if all WELS members look for ways to share their faith," says Rev. Jonathan Hein, coordinator of WELS Congregational Services.

WELS Congregational Services is providing in-field help and online resources like C18 materials to assist congregations as they reach and retain the generations to come.

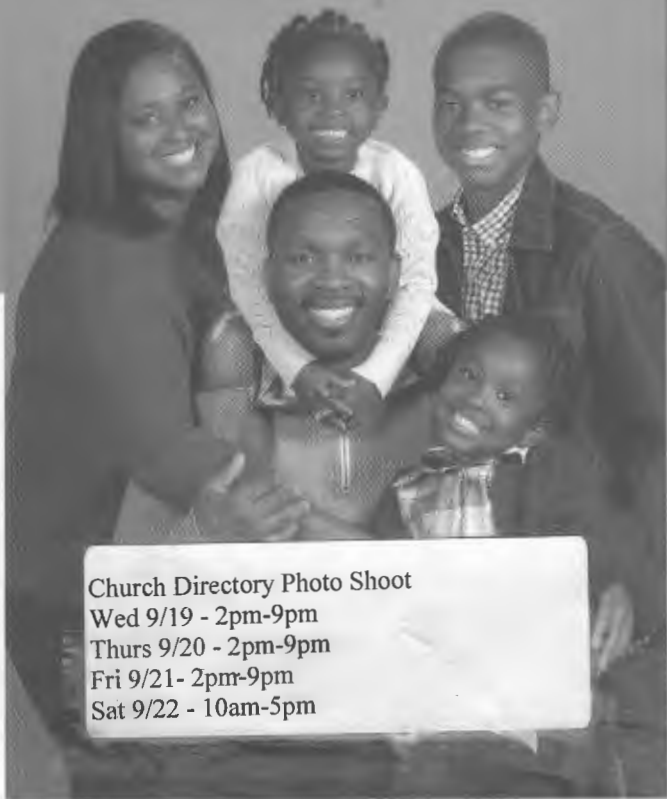
