Dear Members of Siloah Ev Lutheran Church:

I saw a familiar face in my Bible class at the prison a while ago. Jimmy had attended regularly for many months until his release from prison almost two years ago. He had always been upbeat and regularly shared insightful comments with the class as we studied God's Word together. Today, however, Jimmy's face was downcast. When he refused even to make the briefest of eye contact with me, it dawned on me what was troubling him. Jimmy was filled with self-disgust!

He sat quietly during the class, listening intently as we talked about sin and grace, and God's mercy and forgiveness. At one point, Jimmy became so overwhelmed that he left the room to compose himself. Like Peter running out into the night after failing his LORD in the courtyard of the High Priest, Jimmy was overwhelmed by his failure before God. He was *out*. He was *free*. He was certain that he had put this part of his life behind him. But here he was again, back *inside*.



Like the prodigal son discovering the depths of his father's love for him, Jimmy was rediscovering just "how wide and long and high and deep" the heavenly Father's love is for sinners — that even when "we are faithless, he remains faithful" (*Eph 3:18; 2Tm 2:13*).

Paul once said, "We must go through many hardships to enter the kingdom of God," reminding us that the life of a Christian is not one grand and glorious procession of triumph after triumph, and victory after victory (Acts 14:22). The cross comes before the crown, and the path we walk will be filled with setbacks and hardship.
