Greetings in our Lord Jesus! We hope that your summer ministries are off to a great start!

"In the same way, the gospel is bearing fruit and growing throughout the whole world—just as it has been doing among you since the day you heard it and truly understood God's grace" (Colossians 1:6).

The message of God's boundless grace for sinners is truly amazing! The Holy Spirit has worked through that message to open doors to an opportunity that we may not have imagined possible: providing theological training in communist Vietnam.

In December 2018, our synod launched a special synodwide campaign to encourage support for Hmong outreach in Vietnam. The goal of the "Grace—Hmong outreach in Vietnam" offering is to receive gifts totaling \$2 million to fund the land purchase, building construction, and the first two years of operational costs for the theological training facility in Hanoi.

With construction in Vietnam already underway, we are pleased to report that WELS members have offered our Savior **more than \$1.2 million toward our \$2 million goal**. Thanks be to our generous Lord!

As a congregation who has already contributed to this effort, we say, "Praise the Lord and thank you, God's people!" Your gift is such a blessing as we share God's grace with the leaders of the 100,000+ member Hmong Fellowship Church and, through them, the 2 million Hmong living in Vietnam and the surrounding countries. Would you please continue to pray for and promote this opportunity in your congregation?
